

Albany Aquatic Center Pool Rules

For Your Health and Safety

- Management may eject any persons from the Albany High School Aquatic Center who is violating these rules or whose conduct or condition is jeopardizing the health, safety or pleasure of others.
- Public restrooms are located in Memorial Park.
- All patrons entering the facility must pay.
- Swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
- Swimmers may enter the pool only when a Lifeguard is on duty and must swim in designated areas.
- Running, pushing, shoving and general horseplay are not allowed.
- All swimmers must wear appropriate swim attire.
- Glass containers, alcoholic beverages, and illegal drugs are not permitted in the facility.
- No food or drinks other than water is allowed in the facility.
- No outside pool equipment may be used.
- For your convenience, patrons may rent a life vest at the front desk for a nominal fee.
- No outside swim toys will be allowed in the facility.
- Mask, snorkels, fins and kick boards are allowed during lessons and lap swim only.
- Standing dives are allowed in the outdoor pool only, in water deeper than 7 ft.
- Playing or hanging on the lane lines is prohibited.
- Lap swim lanes during recreational swim are for adults only (18 years and older).
- For your safety, you and/or your child may be asked to take a swim test.
- If a child does not pass a swim test they must remain within arm's reach of parent at all times.
- Children age 7 and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- A child may accompany a sibling over the age of 14 only if they have both passed the swim test.
- Do not distract the Lifeguards.
- Smoking is prohibited in the facility and all District property.
- Inappropriate behavior in the restrooms and showers is prohibited.
- Bicycles, skateboards, scooters or other vehicles are not permitted in the facility.
- Persons with communicable diseases, infections, open soars or wounds will not be allowed in the pools.
- Patrons should refrain from inappropriate displays of affection in this public, family setting.
- Pets are not allowed. Service animals are allowed on deck but not in the water.
- All persons who are incontinent or not toilet trained must be in swim diapers before entering the pool.
- All changing must take place in the locker rooms. Children over the age of 5 must use restrooms of their same sex. Family restrooms are available for your convenience
- For the safety and security of all our patrons, use of recorders, cameras, cell phone cameras or any other visual recording devices are not allowed within the facility without the express consent of the Aquatics Director.
